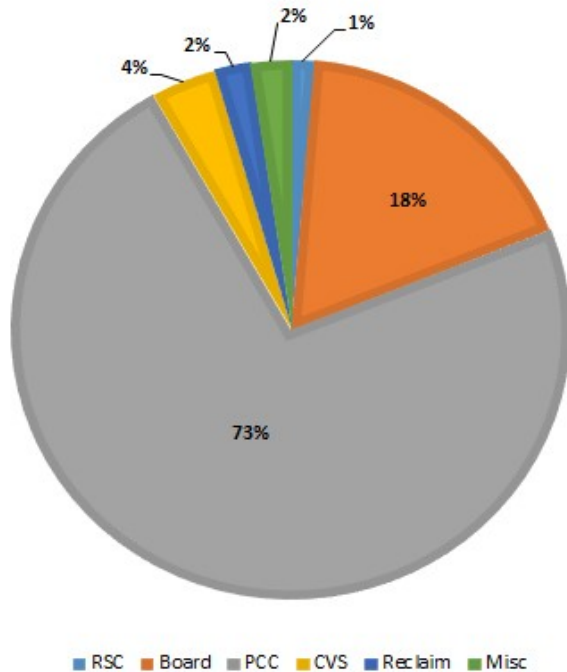

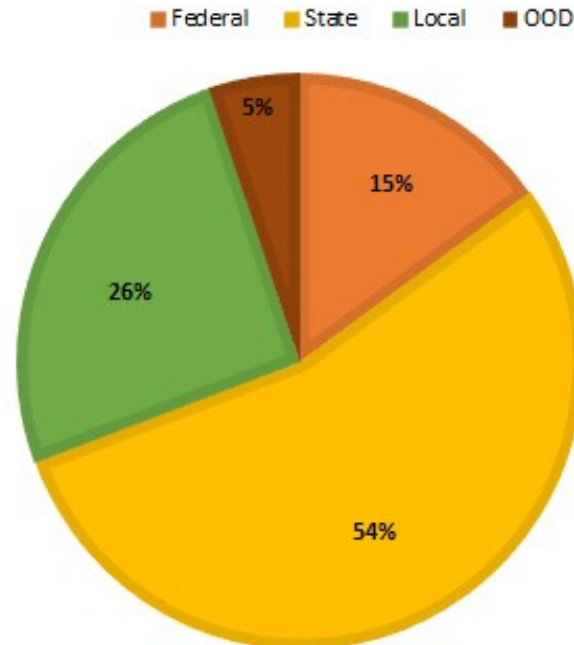


Revenues FY 15
